

FOUNDATION FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION Guidelines and Procedures

Purpose:

The MISDEF's Foundation Fellowships program is designed to encourage, promote, and foster a desire for continued education. We strongly believe that our student's premier education comes from our premier teachers.

Persons Eligible to Apply for Grants:

Individuals employed by Montgomery ISD may apply for a Foundation Fellowship from the Montgomery ISD Education Foundation.

Award of Funds:

Fellowships will be awarded to Montgomery Independent School District. Educators who are pursuing a higher education initiative will receive the fellowship funds from the school district directly.



Selection Criteria for a Foundation Fellowship

- 1. The proposal is submitted through the MISD Education Foundation's Google form.
- 2. The applicant answers all questions and indicates the desired funds being applied for.
- 3. Foundation Fellowship applicants can apply for up to \$2,000.00.
- 4. The proposal is clear and logical.
- 5. All applicants who are enrolled in a continued education program must maintain a 2.5 GPA in order to qualify for a Foundation Fellowship.

Selection Process

- 1. Application forms can be found on the Montgomery ISD Education Foundation website located at https://montgomeryisdef.org/what-we-do/scholarships.html
- 2. Educator applications must be approved by Montgomery Independent School District.
- 3. Applications are due by Monday, December 1, 2025.
- 4. Applicants will be notified of decisions in January 2026.

Responsibilities of Foundation Fellowship Recipients:

- 1. Use the awards for the purpose(s) intended.
- 2. Upload all pertinent information to verify enrollment.
- 3. Agree to share GPA and passing grades with Montgomery ISD Education Foundation if applying for continued Foundation Fellowship the following year.
- 4. Notify the Montgomery ISD Education Foundation if leaving the school district. The Foundation reserves the right to rescind the grant under these circumstances.
